In accordance with ORS 297.465(2), and a copy of that audit report shall be furnished to each person who was a member of the governing body at the end of the fiscal year and to each member of the current governing body.
- 2. <u>FILING OF AUDIT REPORT WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE</u>: The County is required to submit one copy of the annual audit report to the Secretary of State in accordance with ORS 297.465(3).

### III. DISCUSSION

#### A. Auditor Reports

The auditors, Moss Adams, LLP have issued an unqualified opinion on the basic financial statements of Lane County, Oregon, which means they are fairly presented, in all material respects, for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2004.

Moss Adams, LLP has also issued compliance and internal control reports in accordance with the General Accounting Office, the Office of Management and

Budget, and Oregon Revised Statutes that do not include any reportable compliance findings or deficiencies in internal controls.
