PROSPECTIVE CONTRACT NO. 04/05-M&S-52

I. MOTION

THAT THE ATTACHED BOARD ORDER BE ADOPTED AWARDED REQUIREMENT CONTRACTS FOR FURNISHING THE YEARLY NEEDS OF LIQUID ASPHALT MATERIALS, DELIVERY, CRC DISTRIBUTOR AND OPERATOR TO VARIOUS CONTRACTORS AS SPECIFIED IN THE BOARD ORDER, IN THE AMOUNTS NEEDED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004/2005, AND THAT THE CONTRACTS BE EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID SPECIFICATIONS AND THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN THE CONTRACT.

II. ISSUE OR PROBLEM

These contracts are for furnishing liquid asphalt materials, delivery, CRC distributor and operator to be used in maintenance of County roads as needed during the fiscal year 2004/2005.

III. DISCUSSION

A. Background.

Liquid asphalt is applied with rock chips to seal deteriorating hard surface roads to minimize the water intrusion into the road base, protect the old surface from further oxidation and restore skid resistance.

Liquid asphalt materials, delivery, CRC distributor and operator requirement contracts are awarded annually to all qualifying bidders, which guarantees Lane County the best price for the materials, delivery, CRC distributor and operator.

Contract specifications require Lane County to purchase at least \$100.00 of materials from each qualifying bidder. These materials are purchased as needed during the term of the contract; therefore, a contract dollar amount cannot be specified.

B. Analysis.

The application of chip seals prolongs the serviceable life of the existing road surface and postpones the necessity of expensive capital improvements such as asphalt overlays or reconstruction.

C. Alternatives/Options.

Do not apply chip seal services on existing roads throughout Lane County in fiscal year 2004/2005.

D. Recommendation.

Award Requirement Contracts to qualified bidders.

E. Timing.

Upon approval by the Board, these contracts will be executed.


ORDERED that these contracts be executed in accordance with this Order and the bid specifications and the County Administrator be authorized to sign the contracts.
