COMMITTEE CHARGE:

To advise the Board of County Commissioners and Human Services Commission (HSC) on services that alleviate the conditions of poverty and promote and improve the health, well-being, self-sufficiency, and safety of low income, disadvantaged, and disabled Lane County residents. The committee reviews the annual budgets, plans, and evaluations of the operation of human services sponsored by the HSC to insure program effectiveness.

MANDATED: ORS 458.505 (LM 3.530)

C. BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:

The Lane County Board of County Commissioners has served as the governing board for Lane County's Community Action Program since 1972. The Community Action Program is the delivery system for state and federal anti-poverty programs. Since 1983 the operation of this mandated advisory committee for anti-poverty funding in Lane County has functioned to assist the HSC as a part of its budget and planning process. This coupling of functions has allowed for the efficient integration of decision-making in the allocation of funding to local non-profit groups.

This committee has designated slots for recruitment within the mandated tripartite advisory board structure, consisting of equal parts local private sector, public sector, and low-income representatives. The HSC designated slots for recruitment for specific community interests include: clergy, criminal justice programs, health care organizations, consumers, public welfare programs, and advocacy organizations. This structure brings together community leaders from each of these groups to collaborate on developing responses to local needs.

The HSC approved the recommendation of these appointments at their September 16, 2004 meeting, and the May 12, 2005 meeting. Vacant positions had been posted last Spring, however, the HSC did not meet between June and September. Therefore, approval was left for their September agenda.

The Lane Manual allows for four-year terms, ending June 30. However in practice, the HSC has recommended appointment members for two-year staggered terms for a total service of up to eight years.
