II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

Shall Janice L. Mackey be appointed to fill the position of lay citizen member of the Economic Development Standing Committee to the Board of County Commissioners?

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

In November 2003 the Board of Commissioners amended Lane Manual 3.515 to include a fifth member of the Economic Development Standing Committee (EDSC), as shown in Attachment A. Janice Mackey was appointed to this position on April 14, 2004. This year, CAO published a notice of position vacancy in the usual manner, with the closing date May 19, 2006. Attachment B is the posting for the position. One response was received from Janice Mackey, the current citizen appointee to the EDSC. She has served for a period of about two years.

B. Policy Issues

The process for receiving proposals was completed in accordance with usual notice process and selection procedure. It is usual to reappoint advisory committee members when one term is completed. This provides the benefit of the expertise developed during the tenure on the committee. Ms. Mackey has

1. Give a brief description of the experience or training that qualifies you for membership on this advisory committee.
