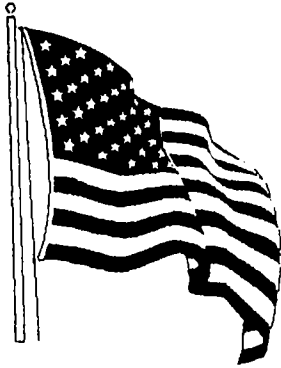

Dear Commissioners,


The Veterans Memorial Park Commission is presently writing a grant for funds for the construction of the proposed Veterans Memorial Park in Florence, West Lane County.
