**WHEREAS**, KRVM is a resource for local musicians and bands to have their music presented to a wide audience of listeners by the playing of CDs and by live interviews with musicians in the KRVM studio; and

**WHEREAS**, KRVM's staff of 50 dedicated volunteers provide 108 hours of creative, inventive and personally selected music for KRVM's listeners each week; and

**WHEREAS**, over the course of 60 years, KRVM has given a start to countless professional broadcasters now residing all over the country; and

**WHEREAS**, 91.9 KRVM is a beloved community radio station to its thousands of listeners.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Lane County Board of Commissioners recognizes December 6<sup>th</sup> as KRVM DAY in recognition of their long history and outstanding service toward the betterment of the citizens of Lane County.
