I. MOTION

TO APPROVE THE ORDER SURRENDERING FIVE COUNTY ROADS, OR PORTIONS THEREOF, TO THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE.

II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

To decide whether or not to approve the Order surrendering five County Roads, or portions thereof, to the City of Cottage Grove.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445) is an Urban Local Street originally established in 1896 as a 60 foot wide County Road. Other segments of this road have been previously surrendered — the last being in 1989 by Ord. No. 89-9-27-6. The segment of road now being proposed for surrender was annexed to the City in 1994, 1999 and 2005 by Annexation Orders EC CG 94-66, C CG 99-65 and C CG 05-20 respectively.

Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27) from West Main Street to County Road 445 is an Urban Major Collector and was established as a 50 foot wide Market Road in 1925. Other segments of this road have been previously surrendered -- the last being in 1989 by Ord. No 89-9-27-6. The segment of this road now being proposed for surrender was annexed to the City in 1994, 1999 and 2005 by Annexation Orders EC CG 91-22, EC CG 98-42 and C CG 06-32 respectively.

6TH Street South (County Road Number 538) is an Urban Minor Arterial originally established in 1904 as a 50 foot wide County Road which was altered in 2000 to a 60 foot wide with intermittent varying widths. Other segments of this road have been previously

surrendered -- the last being in 2001 by Ord. No 01-4-11-7. The segment of this road now being proposed for surrender was annexed to the City in 2006 by Annexation Orders EC CG 05-44.

South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) is a Rural Major Collector and a Rural Local Street originally established in 1855 and legalized in 1989 as a 60 foot wide County Road. Other segments of this road have been previously surrendered -- the last being in 1989 by Ord. No 89-9-27-6. The segments of road now being proposed for surrender was annexed to the City in 1991, 1998 and 2006 by Annexation Orders EC CG 94-66, C CG 99-65 and C CG 05-20 respectively.

North River Road (County Road Number 963) was established in 1923 as a 40 foot wide County Road. Other segments of this road have been previously surrendered -- the last being in 1989 by Ord. No 89-9-27-6. The segment of this road now being proposed for surrender was annexed to the City in 1980 by Annexation Orders C CG 80-20.

The City of Cottage Grove has enacted Resolution Number 1639 formally requesting that jurisdiction over portions of the above mentioned County Roads, all within the city limits and described in Exhibit "A" of the attached Order, be transferred from Lane County to the City of Cottage Grove. The surrender includes 1.22 miles of right of way.

By previous action, the Board of County Commissioners approved Resolution and Order No. 07-10-3-9, setting a Public Hearing for this date.

B. Policy Issues

ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a city. The segments of right-of-way described in Exhibit "A" were annexed into the City of Cottage Grove between 1980 and 2006. The City of Cottage Grove has enacted Resolution Number 1639 formally requesting that jurisdiction over segments of the above mentioned County Roads, all within the city limits and described in Exhibit "A" of the attached Order, be transferred from Lane County to the City of Cottage Grove. This action was initiated by the City without a County/City Roads Partnership Program Agreement. The Public's interest was determined to be benefited when this agreement was reached.

C. Board Goals

There does not appear to be anything within the County goals and the Strategic Plan goals that would not support or be inconsistent with the surrender of jurisdiction of a County Road to an incorporated city.

D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

A County/City Road Partnership Agreement has not been entered into. Therefore, the proposed surrender will not increase the payment to the City of Cottage Grove. Surrender of these County Road segments will transfer maintenance, improvement and development

responsibilities to the City of Cottage Grove. Acceptance of the proposed order would have nominal administrative and recording costs associated with the transfer.

E. Analysis

The segments of the said county roads, as described in Exhibit "A" are under the jurisdiction of Lane County. The proposed surrender will allow the City to maintain, develop and improve these roads, as needed, to the City's specifications, standards and timetable.

F. Alternatives/Options

The Board of County Commissioners has the options to:

- Approve the Order to surrender the segments of County Roads as described in Exhibit "A." Approval of this Order will ensure consistency with the above stated policy issues.
- 2. Deny all or any portion of the Order to surrender these segments of County Roads. Denial may be inconsistent with the above stated policy issues.
- 3. Postpone further action until a future date. Postponement may delay planned development in these areas.

IV. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

Timing in this matter is important as the surrender of these County Roads would address the request by the City of Cottage Grove in a timely manner. Development is planned for these areas and immediate implementation of this Order will allow for the least amount of delay by the County.

V. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

The Director of the Lane County Department of Public Works has prepared a written report recommending that the Board support Option 1, to approve the Order to surrender the described segments of County Roads to the City of Cottage Grove.

VI. FOLLOW-UP

The County Clerk shall file the Final Order in the Commissioner's Journal of Administration and forward copies to the Lane County Surveyor and the Department of Public Works Director for updating appropriate indexes and County Road Records.

WHEREAS, by Resolution and Order Number 07-10-3-9 the Board of Commissioners set November 7, 2007 at 1:30 p.m. to conduct a public hearing on the matter of the surrender of segments of Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963) to the city of Cottage Grove.

WHEREAS, Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street South (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963) were originally established as County Roads in 1896, 1925, 1904, 1855 and 1923 respectively; and

WHEREAS, additional property including segments of Cottage Grove Cemetery Road, Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway, 6TH Street South, South River Road and North River Road have been annexed into the City between 1980 and 2006 by Annexation Orders EC CG 94-66, C CG 99-65, C CG 05-20, EC CG 91-22, EC CG 98-42, C CG 06-32, EC CG 05-44, and CG 80-20; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cottage Grove, by its Resolution Number 1639 has requested that jurisdiction over segments of County Road No. 445, 27, 538, 2224, 295 163, and 963 as described on Exhibit "A" attached to and made a part hereof, by this Resolution and Order, be transferred to the City of Cottage Grove; and

WHEREAS, This action was initiated by the City without a County/City Roads Partnership Program Agreement; and

WHEREAS, ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a City. The County may transfer jurisdiction over county roads, or parts thereof, within a city when it is considered to be necessary, expedient, or in the best interest of the County to do so; and the governing body of the City deems it necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the City to acquire jurisdiction over the County Roads, or portions thereof, and to the same extent as it has over public streets and alleys of the City; and

WHEREAS, Lane County and the City of Cottage Grove deem it necessary and expedient and in the best interest of each governing body to proceed with the transfer of jurisdiction over the portions of the county roads described on the attached Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, there are no known objections to the proposed surrender and it appears that surrender of the segments of Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street South (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963 would be in the best interest of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Lane County Department of Public Works recommends that segments of Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street South (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963 be surrendered, as outlined in the Final Director's Report, Exhibit "B" attached hereto, and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, all legal notice has been provided regarding this matter as required by ORS 373.270, and evidenced by the Affidavit of Posting labeled as Exhibit "C", attached hereto, and made a part hereof; now therefore it is hereby

ORDERED, that Lane County, in accordance with ORS 373.270, hereby surrenders jurisdiction of segments Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street South (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963) as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and made a part hereof, to the City of Cottage Grove; and it is further

ORDERED, that these legal proceedings be filed with the County Clerk's Office in the Commissioners' Journal of Administration, and that a copy be retained in the County Road Records administered by the Director of Public Works and the County Surveyor.

COTTAGE GROVE-LORANE HIGHWAY (MARKET ROAD 27)

Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street South (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963) were originally established as County Roads in 1896, 1925, 1904, 1855 and 1923 respectively. The segments of these roads now being proposed for surrender were annexed into the City between 1980 and 2006 by Annexation Orders EC CG 94-66, C CG 99-65, C CG 05-20, EC CG 91-22, EC CG 98-42, C CG 06-32, EC CG 05-44, and CG 80-20.

The City of Cottage Grove has enacted Resolution Number 1639 formally requesting that jurisdiction over portions of the above mentioned County Roads, all within the city limits and described in Exhibit "A" of the attached Resolution and Order, be transferred from Lane County to the City of Cottage Grove. This action was initiated by the City without a County/City Roads Partnership Program Agreement; however the public's interest has been determined to be benefited.

The proposed surrender includes approximately 0.17 miles for Cottage Grove Cemetery Road, 0.23 miles for Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway, 0.15 miles for 6th Street South, 0.42 miles for South River Road and 0.25 miles for North River Road for a total of approximately 1.22 miles of road.

ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a City. The county may transfer jurisdiction over county roads, or portions thereof, within a city when it is considered to be necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the county to do so; and the governing body of the city deems it necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the city to acquire jurisdiction over the county roads, or portions thereof, to the same extent as it has over other public streets and alleys of the city.

All legal notices for the public hearing to consider the matter of the surrender of these segments of Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street South (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963 has been provided as required by ORS 373.270.

EXHIBIT "B"

The surrender of these segments of road will allow the City to have full jurisdiction of these roads and to maintain, develop and improve them and the surrounding area to their own specification, standards and timetables. It is therefore recommended that the segments of County Road Cottage Grove Cemetery Road (County Road Number 445), Cottage Grove-Lorane Highway (Market Road 27), 6TH Street South (County Road Number 538), South River Road (County Road Number 2224, 295 & 163) and North River Road (County Road Number 963), as described in Exhibit "A", be surrendered to the City of Cottage Grove.

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
