## II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Community Health Centers (CHCs) rely on the Oregon Community Health Information Network (OCHIN) for practice management services and, as the client base/utilization rate of the CHCs expand, so do the costs associated with practice management, as OCHIN charges are accrued on a per-use basis.

# III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

# A. Board Action and Other History

The original OCHIN contract was approved and authority to execute was delegated via BO 04-3-10-9 (\$110,000). Additional amounts were obligated and authority delegated via BO 06-4-26-5 (\$24,703.12) and 06-6-21-2 (\$60,000).

OCHIN is the most commonly utilized practice management service for Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), throughout the Northwest. The CHCs have a
