WHEREAS, it is important to recognize that agencies such as Sexual Assault Support Services provide support to more than 5,000 adult and adolescent survivors of sexual assault in Lane County each year; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize that agencies such as Kids First provide support to more than 700 children survivors of abuse and neglect in Lane County each year; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize that sexual violence and child abuse are preventable; and

WHEREAS, It is important to encourage healthy, non-violent interactions and diminish aspects of society that promote and support child abuse and sexual violence; and

WHEREAS, it is important to broaden the scope and increase the effectiveness of sexual violence and child abuse prevention efforts through partnerships; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize the compassion and dedication of the individuals who provide services to survivors and work to prevent child abuse and sexual violence; and

WHEREAS, every individual and community in Lane County has the ability to help eliminate sexual violence and child abuse by working together to promote social change.

NOW, THEREFORE: The Lane County Board of Commissioners, join with the City of Eugene to hereby proclaim April 2009 to be SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH and CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH in Lane County and we urge all citizens to join in this observance.
