### I. <u>MOTION</u>

THAT THE ATTACHED BOARD ORDER IS ADOPTED AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR PRE-COATED OIL ROCK MATERIALS FOR VARIOUS STOCKPILE SITES, PROSPECTIVE CONTRACT NO. 08/09-06, TO WILDISH BUILDING MATERIALS DBA WILDISH SAND & GRAVEL, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$322,238.15; DIRECTING THAT THE CONTRACT BE EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID SPECIFICATIONS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACT; AND REQUIRING THE CONTRACTOR TO PRESENT A PERFORMANCE BOND AND PAYMENT BOND IN THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT.

# II. <u>DISCUSSION</u>

### A. Background / Analysis

Through approval of the fiscal year 2008-2009 Lane County budget, the Board has authorized funding to obtain rock for use in road maintenance activities.

This contract provides for the furnishing, hauling, and stockpiling of ½" - #10 Pre-Coated Oil Rock in stockpile, 1100 Tons; 3/8" - #10 Pre-Coated Oil Rock in stockpile; 10,185 Tons and all other work and materials as called for in the plans and specifications for stockpiling at various sites throughout Lane County.

The pre-coated oil rock will be used in the County's chip sealing program. Locating the oil rock in several locations reduces the expense of transporting material long distances to work sites. Stockpile sites also ensure that the appropriate materials are available when needed.

Oil rock could be purchased on an as-needed basis; however, using a private

contractor to haul oil rock to stockpile sites early in the year makes for a more efficient operation. This has been a standard practice for many years. During the summer, trucking is at a premium and private haulers may not be available. In addition, using County forces to haul rock long distances to project sites slows work progress. The proposed stockpiling acquisition method is more cost effective and helps to ensure the availability of material when needed.

# B. Recommendation

Award contract to the low qualified bidder.
