#### Α. Background / Analysis

Mental retardation and other developmental disabilities affect more than 7 million Americans and their families. In Lane County four thousand people with developmental disabilities live, work and recreate in our communities. The Lane County Developmental Disabilities Services (LCDDS) is working together with a group of local agencies to raise public awareness about developmental disabilities and to increase local efforts toward enabling people with developmental disabilities to live full and productive lives of inclusion in our communities.

Adult foster care is one crucial residential component in the developmental disabilities system. LCDDS wishes to acknowledge the importance this year

of these hard-working providers, who provide care in a family atmosphere to more than 275 adults in Lane County.

A photographic exhibit focusing on adult foster care providers and the individuals they serve will be displayed during the month of March, in the gallery outside Harris Hall in the Public Service Building.
