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**I. MOTION**

**THAT THE ATTACHED BOARD ORDER BE ADOPTED AWARDING REQUIREMENT CONTRACTS FOR FURNISHING THE YEARLY NEEDS OF LIQUID ASPHALT MATERIALS, DELIVERY, CRC DISTRIBUTOR AND OPERATOR TO VARIOUS CONTRACTORS IN THE AMOUNTS NEEDED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 AS SPECIFIED IN THE BOARD ORDER; THAT THE CONTACTS BE EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID SPECIFICATIONS; AND THAT THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN THE CONTRACTS.**

**II. DISCUSSION**

**A. Background / Analysis**

These contracts are for furnishing liquid asphalt materials, delivery, CRC distributor and operator to be used in maintenance of County roads as needed during the fiscal year 2009-2010. Contracts are awarded annually to all qualifying bidders, which guaranty Lane County the best price for materials, delivery, CRC distributor and operator.

Liquid asphalt is applied with rock chips to seal deteriorating hard surface roads (also referred to as "chip seals") to minimize the water intrusion into the road base, protect the old surface from further oxidation and restore skid resistance.

Contract specifications require Lane County to purchase at least \$100.00 of materials from each qualifying bidder. These materials are purchased as needed during the term of the contract and, therefore, a contract dollar amount cannot be specified.

The application of chip seals prolongs the serviceable life of the existing road surface and postpones the necessity of expensive capital improvements such as asphalt overlays or reconstruction. The average bid figures from last year are compared with this year's averages to show cost increases as follows:

**ORDERED** that these contracts be executed in accordance with this Order and the bid specifications and the County Administrator be authorized to sign the requirement contracts.


