I. MOTION

TO APPROVE THE ORDER TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING DATE OF AUGUST 25, 2010 AT 1:30 P.M., FOR THE SURRENDER OF PORTIONS OF PIONEER PARKWAY EAST (CO. RD. 2151); PIONEER PARKWAY WEST (CO. RD. 2150); HAYDEN BRIDGE WAY (CO. RD. 667); HARLOW ROAD (CO. RD. 439); WAYSIDE LANE (CO. RD. 1642); AND GAME FARM ROAD (CO. RD. 3) TO THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD

II. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

The Board is being asked to approve the Order to set a public hearing date to consider the surrender of these county roads, or portions thereof, to the City of Springfield.

III. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

The City of Springfield has enacted Resolution Number 10-33, dated June 7, 2010, formally requesting the jurisdiction of the county roads listed in Exhibit "A", attached to the Order to set a public hearing, be transferred from Lane County to the City of Springfield. The City is requesting this surrender without a Partnership Program Agreement.

An Intergovernmental Agreement executed in 2003 between Lane County and the City of Springfield for the Pioneer Parkway Extension project (Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway) stipulated that upon completion of the project county roads within the project would be transferred to city jurisdiction. In addition to the portions of Pioneer Parkway East and Pioneer Parkway West that were part of that project, and to facilitate additional jurisdictional transfers within previously annexed territory, portions of Hayden Bridge Way,

Harlow Road, Wayside Lane and Game Farm Road are also included in this surrender process. All of the listed roads are within the City of Springfield city limits, and consist of a total of 0.70 miles of right of way.

B. <u>Policy Issues</u>

ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a city. The county may transfer jurisdiction over county roads, or portions thereof, within a city when it is considered to be necessary, expedient, or in the best interest of the county to do so; and the governing body of the city deems it necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the city to acquire jurisdiction over the county roads, or portions thereof, to the same extent as it has over public streets and alleys of the city.

C. <u>Board Goals</u>

Part of Lane County's Strategic Plan is to "contribute to appropriate community development in the area of transportation and.......land development" (Lane County Strategic Plan, Goals, P. 8). The surrender of these county roads, or portions thereof, will be consistent with this goal by transferring jurisdiction of these rights of way which lie within the city limits to the City of Springfield.

D. <u>Financial and/or Resource Considerations</u>

Since there is no current Partnership Program Agreement in effect, there is no monetary consideration associated with this surrender. Surrender of these portions of county roads will transfer maintenance, improvement and development responsibilities to the City of Springfield. There are nominal administrative and recording costs associated with the transfer.

IV. ANALYSIS

The listed county roads are all under the jurisdiction of Lane County. The proposed surrender will allow the City to have full jurisdiction over the subject roads so that they can maintain, develop and improve them as necessary to the City's specifications, standards and timetable.

ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a city. Setting the above hearing date is a necessary step in the process of surrender and transfer of jurisdiction from Lane County to the City of Springfield.

Setting this date for the hearing will allow time for public posting or notice and is recommended as being appropriate if the issue of timing is to be addressed.

The attached Order will set a public hearing to consider the merits of the surrender and transfer of jurisdiction of the described portions of county roads to the City of Springfield as requested by the City.

V. ALTERNATIVES/OPTIONS

The Board of County Commissioners has the option to:

- 1. Approve the Order to set a public hearing to consider the surrender of these county roads, or parts thereof, to the City of Springfield.
- Deny all or any portion of the Order to set a public hearing to consider surrender of said roads.
- 3. Postpone further action until a future date.

VI. <u>TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION</u>

Timing of this matter is important in order to facilitate the transfer of these county roads, or portions thereof, to the City of Springfield within the 150 day effective period stipulated in the City's ordinance requesting the transfer, and also to facilitate timely jurisdictional developmental planning by the City of Springfield associated with the subject roads and properties in the area.

VII. RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Director's Preliminary Report recommends the Board of Commissioners approve Option 1. This will approve the Order to set a public hearing for the proposed surrender of these county roads, or portions thereof, as described in Exhibit "A" of the Order. Setting the above hearing date will allow time for public posting or notice.

VIII. FOLLOW-UP

Upon approval of the Order to set a public hearing, the County Surveyor will carry out the necessary steps under ORS 373.270 to provide public notice of the hearing. Subsequently, a final report will be prepared and submitted at that hearing by the Director of the Public Works Department. If the Board is in support of surrendering the described roads to the City of Springfield, a Final Order will be prepared for their approval.

WHEREAS, Lane County and the City of Springfield deem it necessary and expedient and in the best interest of each governing body to proceed with the surrender and transfer of jurisdiction over the above described county roads, now therefore, it is hereby

In addition to the portions of Pioneer Parkway East and Pioneer Parkway West that were part of that project, and to facilitate additional jurisdictional transfers within previously annexed territory, portions of Hayden Bridge Way, Harlow Road, Wayside Lane and Game Farm Road are also included in this surrender process. All of the listed roads are within the City of Springfield city limits.

The various roads, consisting of a total of 0.70 miles of right of way, are listed in Exhibit "A" attached to and made a part of the Order setting a public hearing on the proposed surrender of said roads. The subject roads are currently under the jurisdiction of Lane County, and the transfer of jurisdiction over these county roads would enable the City to maintain, develop, and improve the roads to the City's own specifications, standards, and timetables.

ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a city. The county may transfer jurisdiction over county roads, or portions thereof, within a city when it is considered to be necessary, expedient, or in the best interest of the county to do so; and the governing body of the city deems it necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the city to acquire jurisdiction over the county roads, or portions thereof, to the same extent as it has over public streets and alleys of the city.

It is recommended that the Order be approved setting a public hearing on the proposed surrender of jurisdiction of these county roads, or portions thereof, as described in Exhibit "A" of said Order.
