I. MOTION

In The Matter of Accepting Revenues in the Amount of \$2,500,000 from the Cities of Eugene and Springfield for Human Services Programs.

II. DISCUSSION

A. Background/Analysis

Lane County, the City of Eugene and the City of Springfield have determined that it is in their best mutual interest to manage the funding of human services as a consortium under the direction of an intergovernmental committee, the Human Services Commission. Lane County Health & Human Services Department (H&HS) is responsible for the administration and management of the human services programs.

This consolidation approach has allowed participating governments to avoid creating duplicate contracting systems for social services and provides for coordinated planning, monitoring, and evaluation of social service activities.

The H&HS Human Services Commission (HSC) program combines the consortium funds with federal, state, and local resources to contract for services with local agencies through an open, competitive process.

B. Recommendation

The H&HS recommends approval of the motion stated above to accept revenues in the amount of \$2,500,000 from the Cities of Eugene and Springfield.
