**Final Ballot Title** The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the city's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

Authorizes general obligation bonds to fix streets.

Shall City of Springfield issue \$20,000,000 in principal amount of general obligation bonds to fix deteriorating streets?

If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Summary** 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

If this measure is approved, City will use bond proceeds to fix streets. Bond proceeds will only be used to fix existing streets and pay bond issuance costs. The City expects to fix the streets listed below with bond proceeds. See Springfield Resolution 2024-05 for a full list of streets that could be fixed using bond proceeds if funds are available.

Harlow Road: I-5 to Pioneer Parkway/MLK Jr. Parkway roundabout

Aspen Street: Menlo Loop to Centennial Boulevard

'G' Street: 10th Street to 23rd Street

36th Street: Main Street to Commercial Avenue

Daisy Street: South 51st Place to Bob Straub Parkway

58th Street: Main Street to Thurston Road

The City will publish periodic reports to document completed bond projects.

The City expects to levy taxes for five years to repay the Bonds. The estimated rate is \$0.74 per \$1000 of assessed value, or about \$135 per year (\$11.25 per month) for the average Springfield homeowner.
