## RESULTS

For **floodplain verification**, your parcel will be mapped on a copy of the FEMA floodplain map. The Base Flood Elevation (BFE) will be determined for areas in the "AE" zone. For **substantial improvement/damage determination**, the applicant must provide an estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement or repair, and the market value of the structure to be improved. See the **Substantial Improvement/Substantial Damage handout** for more information.

If applying for a substantial improvement/substantial damage determination, staff will evaluate the information provided and determine if the proposed work is a substantial or non-substantial improvement/damage. Based on the results of this application, you will have several options for addressing the floodplain requirements of LC 16.244.
